## What happens then

Your completed application form and any additional information will be short listed by a panel of four judges, and measured against the criteria included in the application pack.

You will then be contacted after the closing date (5th May) to say whether you have been short listed or not. If you are successful, the judges will visit your project for a maximum of 25 minutes on either the 24th, 25th or 26th May.

Your organisation will then receive an invitation for four people to the presentation evening at the Riverside Centre, Newport on the 24th June 2010.

## Recognition

All short listed projects will be featured in the IW County Press and receive a Certificate of Merit in recognition of their excellent work. The Awards will be presented by Lieutenant Colonel Sir Guy Acland, Bt., LVO, DL.
